Attention Bryant Student:

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 requires that Bryant University conduct direct outreach reminding all federal financial aid recipients about the opportunity to communicate changes in family financial circumstances associated with recent change in employment circumstances to your counselor in the financial aid office.

If your- or your family's financial situation has changed significantly from what is reflected on your federal income tax return (for example, if you've lost a job or otherwise experienced a significant drop in income), you may be eligible to have your federal financial aid (*i.e.*, Federal Pell Grant, Federal SEOG, *etc.*) adjusted.
